My unorthodox approach in the hot shop has allowed me to start manipulating it intuitively, responding quickly to the ever changing liquid state of the molten glass', 'Hot-glass doesn't need polishing and I have kept a direct intuitive and natural roughness in my approach to manipulating the glass'.
