A pendant light consisting of stacked glass tubes interwoven with silk cord. There are three lights available in the collection;

Large size limited edition light - as above, 20 lights

This comes only in the following combination: smoke glass, black cord and silver plated fittings

Large size production light - 90cm high, 52cm diameter, 20 lights

Small size production light -69cm high, 39cm diameter, 14 lights

The production light is available in several cord colours, clear glass with either chrome, nickle or brass

Artist description:

In 1823, Josef Lobmeyr opened a small glass shop off Karnterstrasse in the city centre of Vienna. Within two years business was flourishing and in 1835 the first large table service was delivered to Emperor Ferdinand. Lobmeyr eventually became purveyor to the Imperial Court of Vienna. The company also made table settings and chandeliers for the Schonbrunn Castle.
