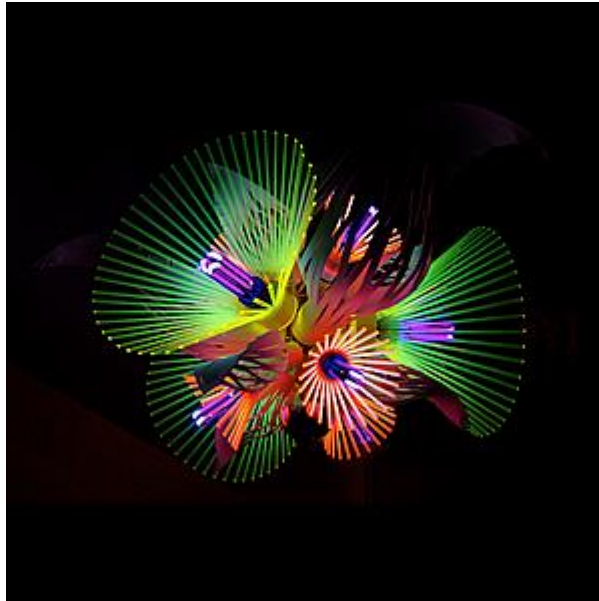

'Blooming Spark' is a limited edition sculptural light by the Taiwanese and Japanese artists, Hsiao-Chi Tsai and Kimiya Yoshikawa.

Well known for their public and private commissions, Hsiao-Chi and Kimiya, have produced exclusively for Vessel Gallery a vibrant unique sculptural chandelier in acrylic that resembles a bouquet of alien botany.
